Rules & Regulations

1. Entries must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow all instructions from law enforcement, parade officials. The Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade, either prior to assembly, at assembly, or anytime during the parade.
2. Accepted pre-entries will receive information regarding assembly area, map, and further instructions.
3. Line-up is first come, first served but may be changed at the discretion of the Parade Committee.
4. Race Cars may not operate under their own power, push trucks are okay.
5. No items may be thrown along the parade route for safety reasons. Passing out items is okay.
6. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade will be removed from the lineup.
7. Commercial Entries: Please include a \$50 check payable to Elma Chamber of Commerce, along with your application.
8. Each parade entry is fully responsible to sign the Hold Harmless Agreement.
9. All motorized vehicles must be driven by licensed drivers.
10. All participants standing on floats must be wearing a safety belt or have handholds while the float is moving.

Equestrian Unit Requirements

1. No stallions
2. Each rider or group must provide its own cleanup unit
3. Equestrian units may debark from their trailer when the unit's clean-up crew is on site.
4. Any rider, regardless of age, showing an inability to control their animal will be removed from the Parade at the Parade Committee's discretion.
